The American Cancer Society is on a mission to free the world from cancer. For more than 100 years, we have helped lead an evolution in the way the world prevents, detects, treats, and thinks about cancer.

As the nation's preeminent cancer-fighting organization, we fund and conduct research, share expert information, support people with cancer, spread the word about prevention, and through our advocacy affiliate, ACS CAN, advocate for public policy change. We are committed to ensuring that ALL people have a fair and just opportunity to prevent, find, treat, and survive cancer.

OUR IMPACT IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CANCER

The <u>COVID-19 pandemic</u> has had a significant impact on people with cancer, their families, and caregivers. Thanks to the unwavering support of our volunteers, the American Cancer Society has been able to sustain its lifesaving mission of research, advocacy, and patient support despite the pandemic. Here's how:

- The Society was able to maintain 2020 funding commitments totaling more than \$334 million invested across 546 multi-year research grants. The Society was able to fund 79 new grants, totaling \$36 million starting in spring 2020.
- The Society continued to fund projects to eliminate health disparities, with \$1.7 million invested in 17 grant projects focused on prevention, early detection, and access to care in underserved communities in the Northeast.
- The organization launched a Diversity in Cancer Research Internship program to fund biomedical internships for undergraduate students from ethnic or racial backgrounds that are underrepresented in the scientific community.
- After ten years of advocacy, ACS CAN eliminated a colorectal cancer screening loophole which resulted in costly surprise bills for senior citizens.
- ACS CAN led efforts to pass the Henrietta Lacks Bill which is a first step towards ensuring that communities of color are represented in clinical trials.
- In the first quarter of 2020, the ACS provided 31,000 rides to cancer patients in the Northeast, saving patients \$1.5 million. We provided nearly 27,000 nights of lodging, saving patients more than \$5 million.
